WEBER RIVER ACCESS TO LOST CREEK

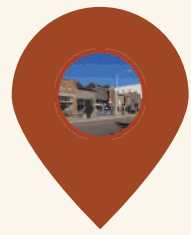

SOUTH MORGAN TO BIG MOUNTAIN

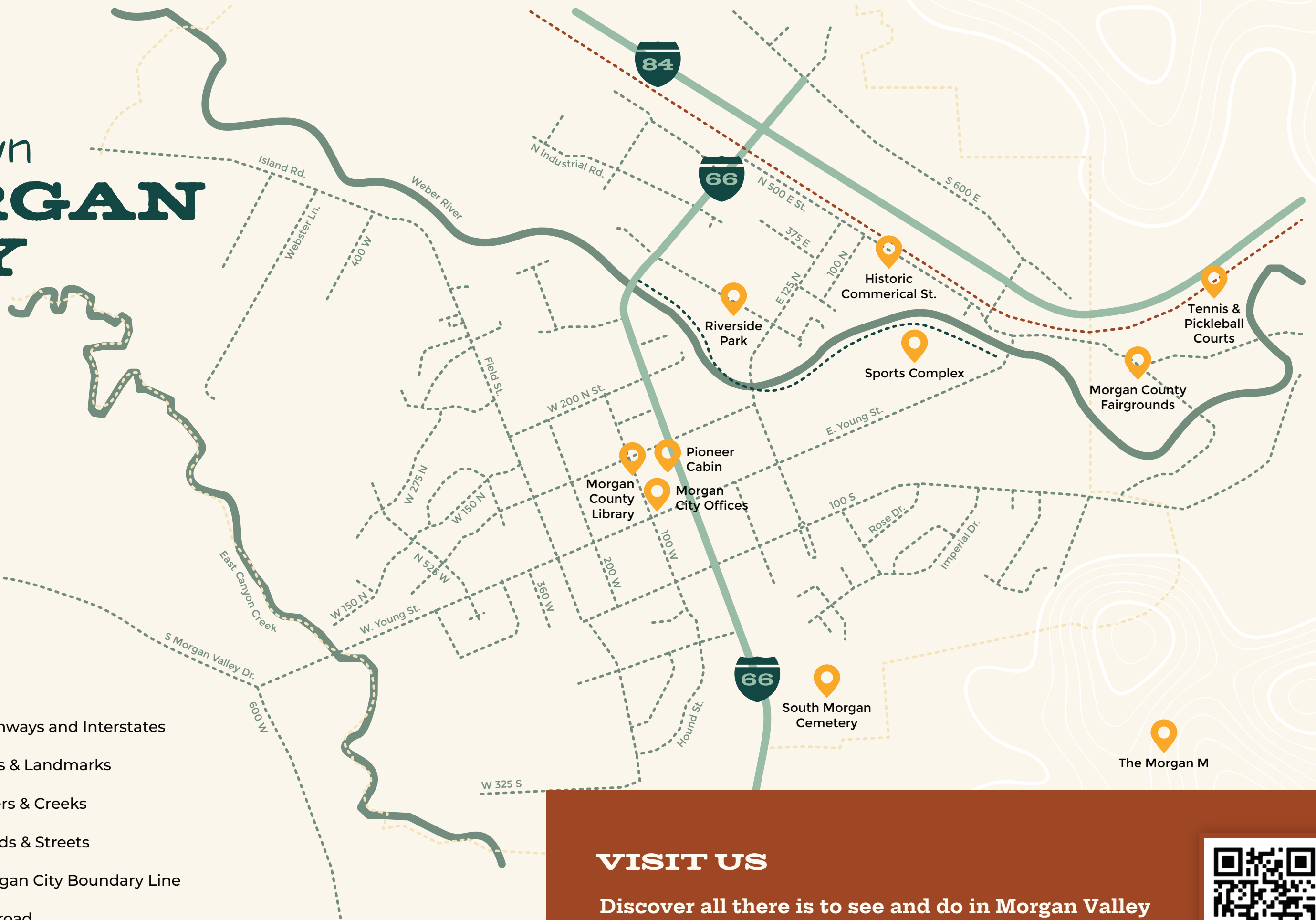
